RESOLUTION EXPRESSING DEEP SENCE OF SORROW AT THE SERIOUS LOSS OF LIFE AND PROPERTY SUFFERED BY THE PEOPLE OF A.P. ON ACCOUNT OF CYCLONE AND TIDAL WAVE.

I request the Members of the House to observe two minutes silence.
